Fire Battalion Chief Greg Hostetler Retired from the Redlands Fire Department on February 23 with 28 years of service on February 23, 2009.

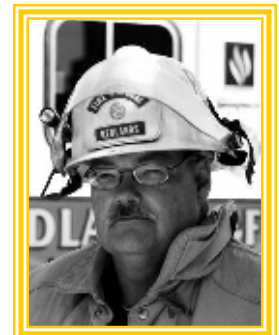


Ralph Morrison retired from the Redlands Fire department with 26 years of service at the rank of Fire Engineer on February 26, 2009.
