

REQUEST FOR COUNCIL ACTION

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SECOND INSTALLMENT AND PAYMENT FOR ARTISTIC SERVICES

MOTION: I move to approve the second installment and payment of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$3,900) to Linda Pew for completion of the production of a final clay mold of a sculpture to honor families who have lost loved ones in service of the United States of America.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Cultural Arts Commission voted unanimously at the March 12, 2007 meeting to recommend Council approval of the clay mold and authorize the Council to instruct the Contractor to complete, deliver and install the finished sculpture.

DISCUSSION:

Attached is the Independent Contractor Agreement. On September 19, 2006, City Council entered into an agreement with Linda Pew to provide a bronze statue. Ms. Pew has provided the necessary sketches for the concept, and has completed a clay mold of approximately three (3) feet tall, two figure models to represent the final bronze statue. The Cultural Arts Commission has viewed the clay mold and recommends a final statue to be made and installed at the City's selected installation site.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Contractor will receive \$3,900 for the second installment of the project, of which 100% of the funds were donated to the City.
