SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF THE SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT PROGRAM GRANT PROJECT #SC073612 FOR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITH PRIMARY FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AND AUTHORIZATION OF AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$51,631.44.

MOTION: I move to accept the Sobriety Checkpoint Program Grant Project #SC073612 for Local Law Enforcement Agencies and authorize an additional appropriation in the amount of \$51,631.44.

DISCUSSION:

The Regents of the University of California, School of UC Berkeley, with primary funding from the California Office of Traffic Safety awarded the police department a one year Sobriety Checkpoint grant to pay for police personnel overtime. The overtime hours will be utilized to pay for police personnel to set-up, conduct and breakdown checkpoints throughout the City of Redlands. The total cost of the program is \$51,631.44, which provides for seven (7) DUI checkpoints.
