Part 1 Crime Summary 03/21/2011 to 04/03/2011

Violent Part 1 Crimes are down by 64% compared to the same time period last year. Homicide, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assaults are below last year's level. Comparison of year-to-date numbers reflects a 42% decrease.

Property Crimes reflect a decrease of 14% compared to the same time period last year. Burglary over all shows a 32% decrease. Residential burglary shows a 63% decrease although Commercial burglary is up by 17%. Theft including theft and burglary from vehicles are down. Auto Theft has doubled during this reporting period.

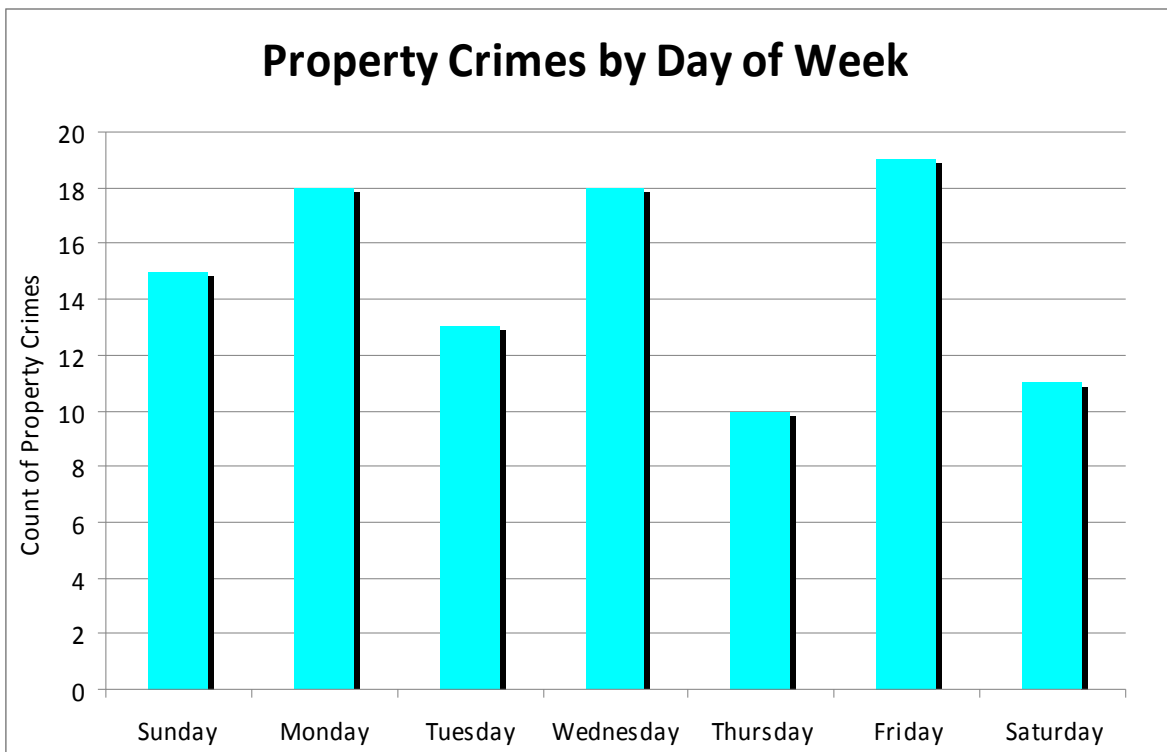
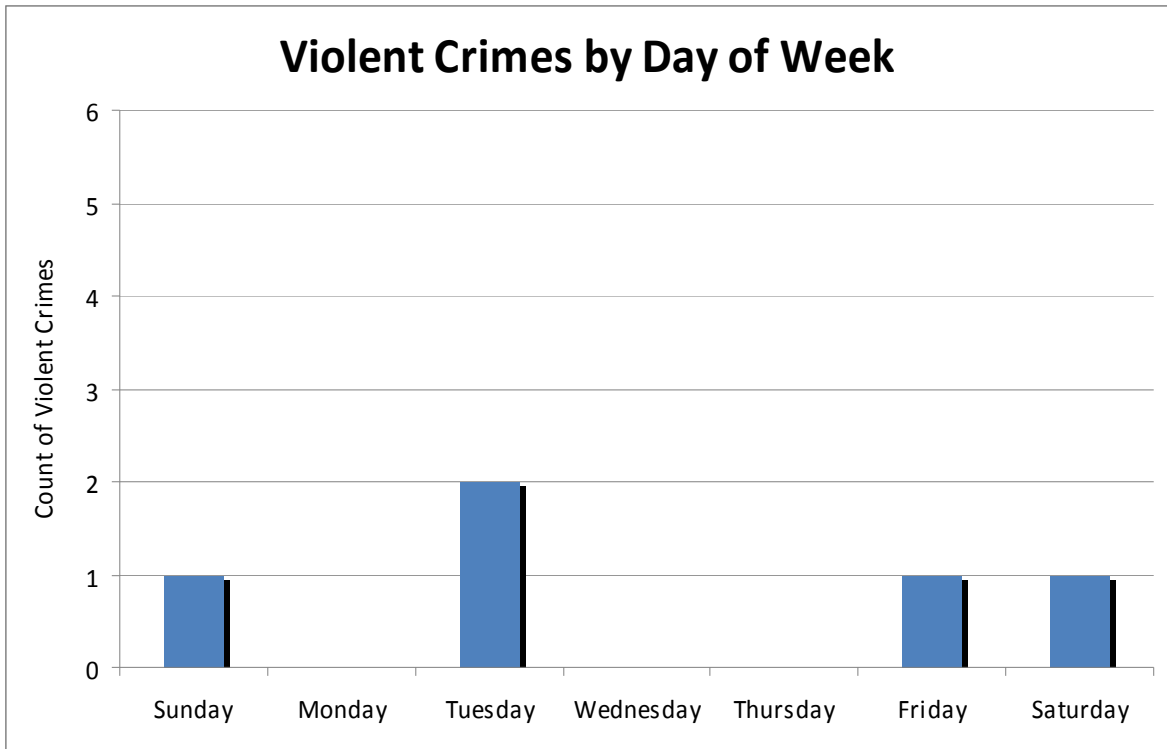
Geographically Auto Theft is not in one particular area and in looking at the make and models of the vehicles stolen there is not any particular vehicle being targeted.

Year-to-date Part 1 Crimes show a 6% decrease compared to 2010 numbers.

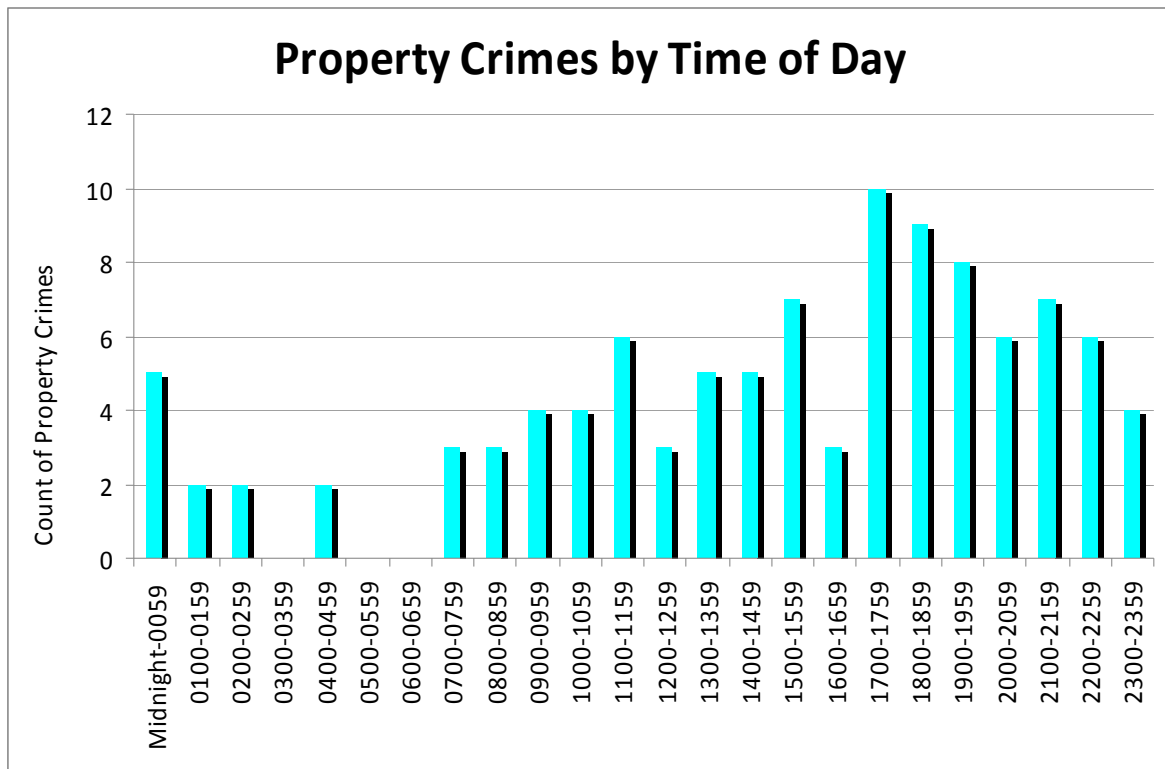
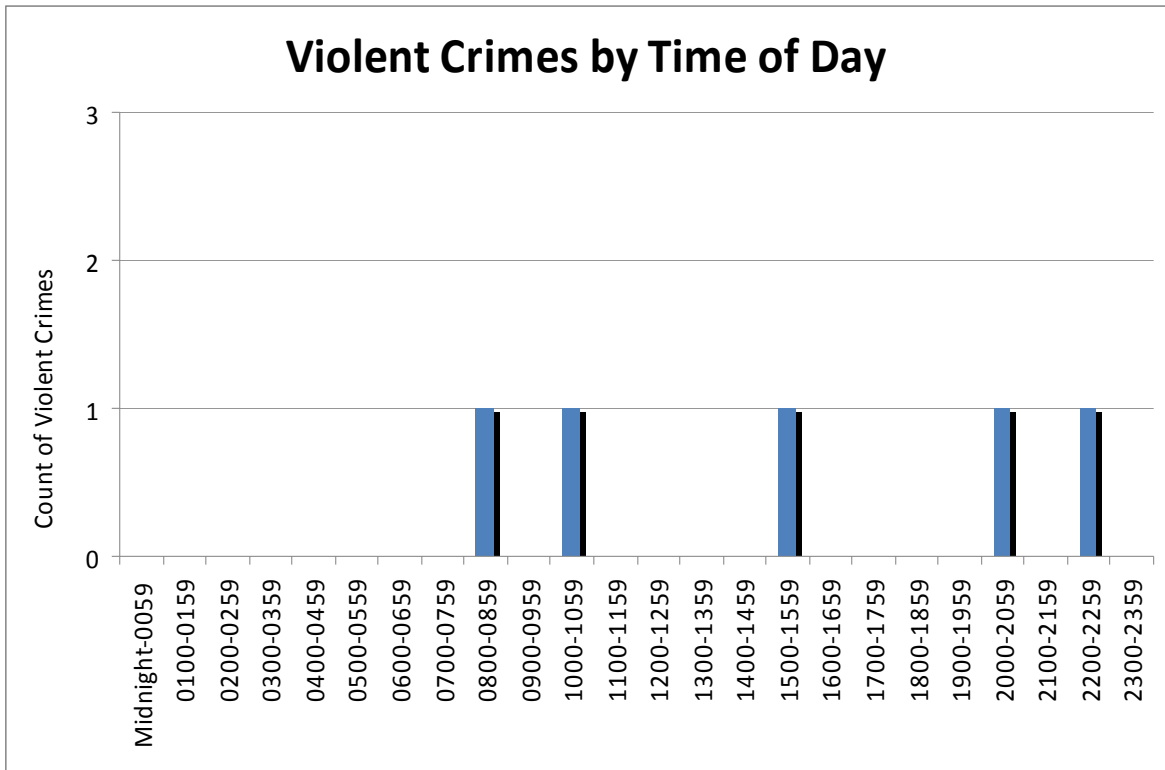
Traffic stops, Field interviews and Pedestrian stops depicted on this chart are down in the current two week period.

Arrests for the previous 14 day period are 33% higher than the same time period last year. Year-to-date Arrest comparisons are showing a 52% decrease.

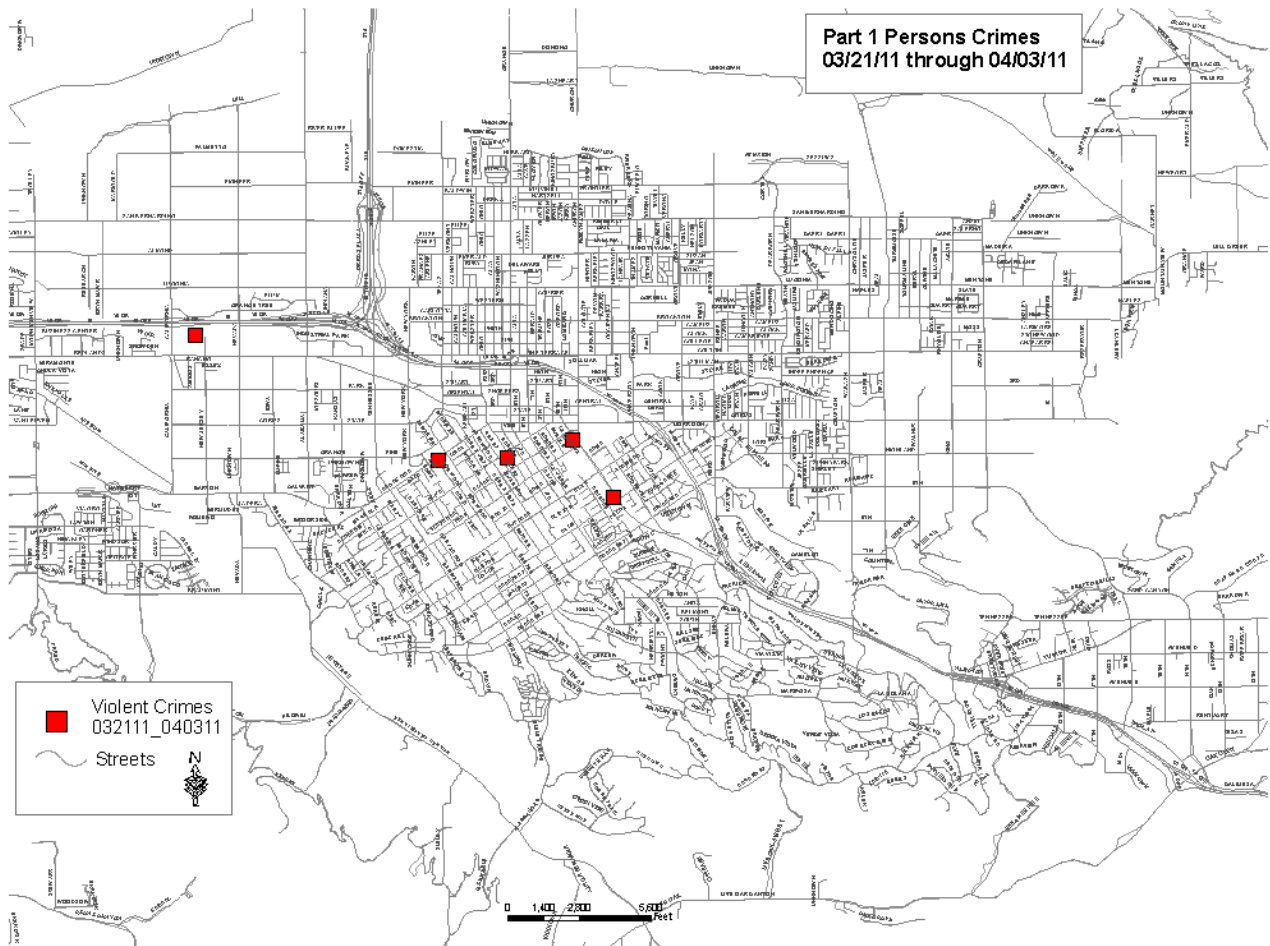
Violent and Property Crime by Day of Week



Violent and Property Crime by Time of Day

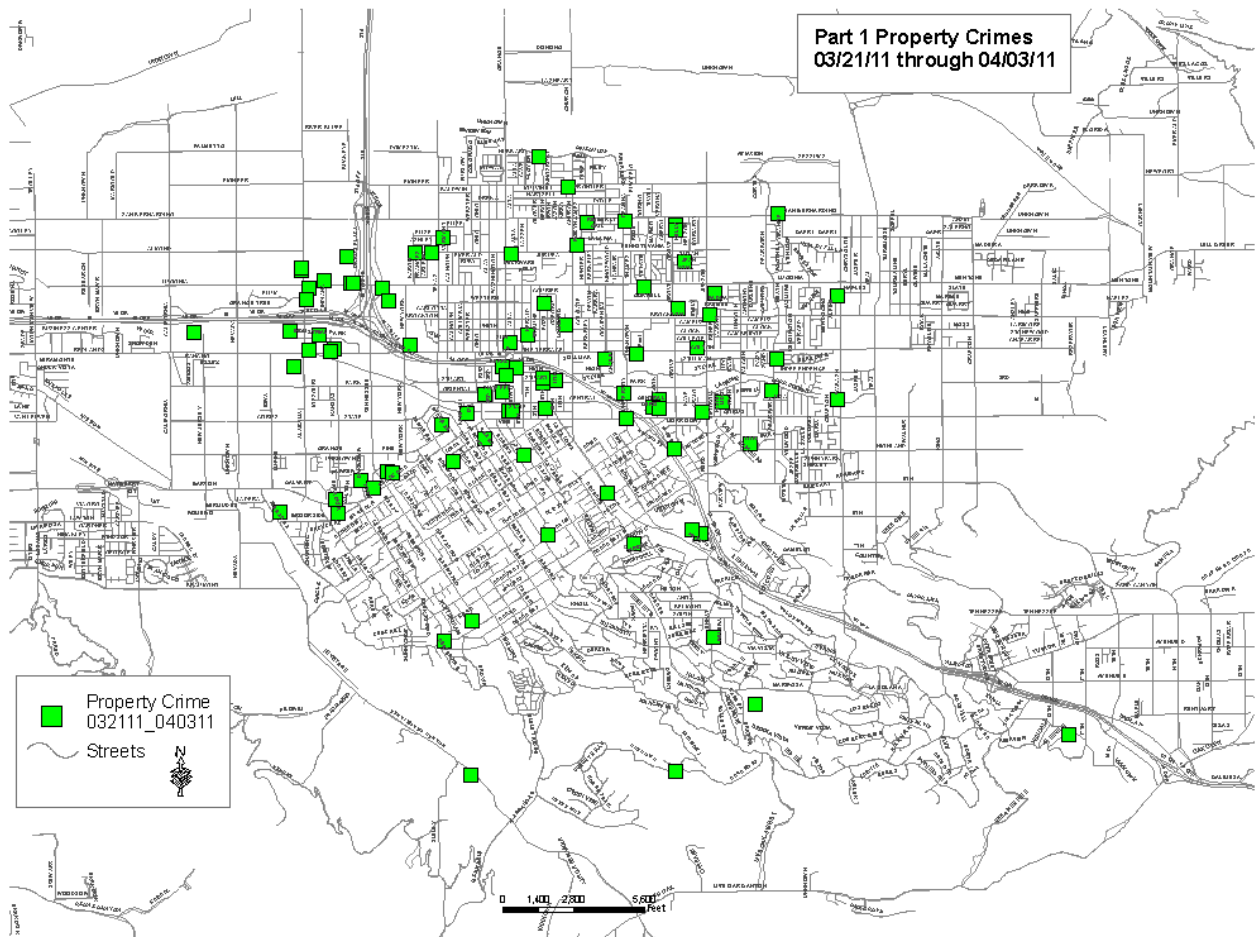


Violent Crime locations for 03/21/11 through 04/03/11



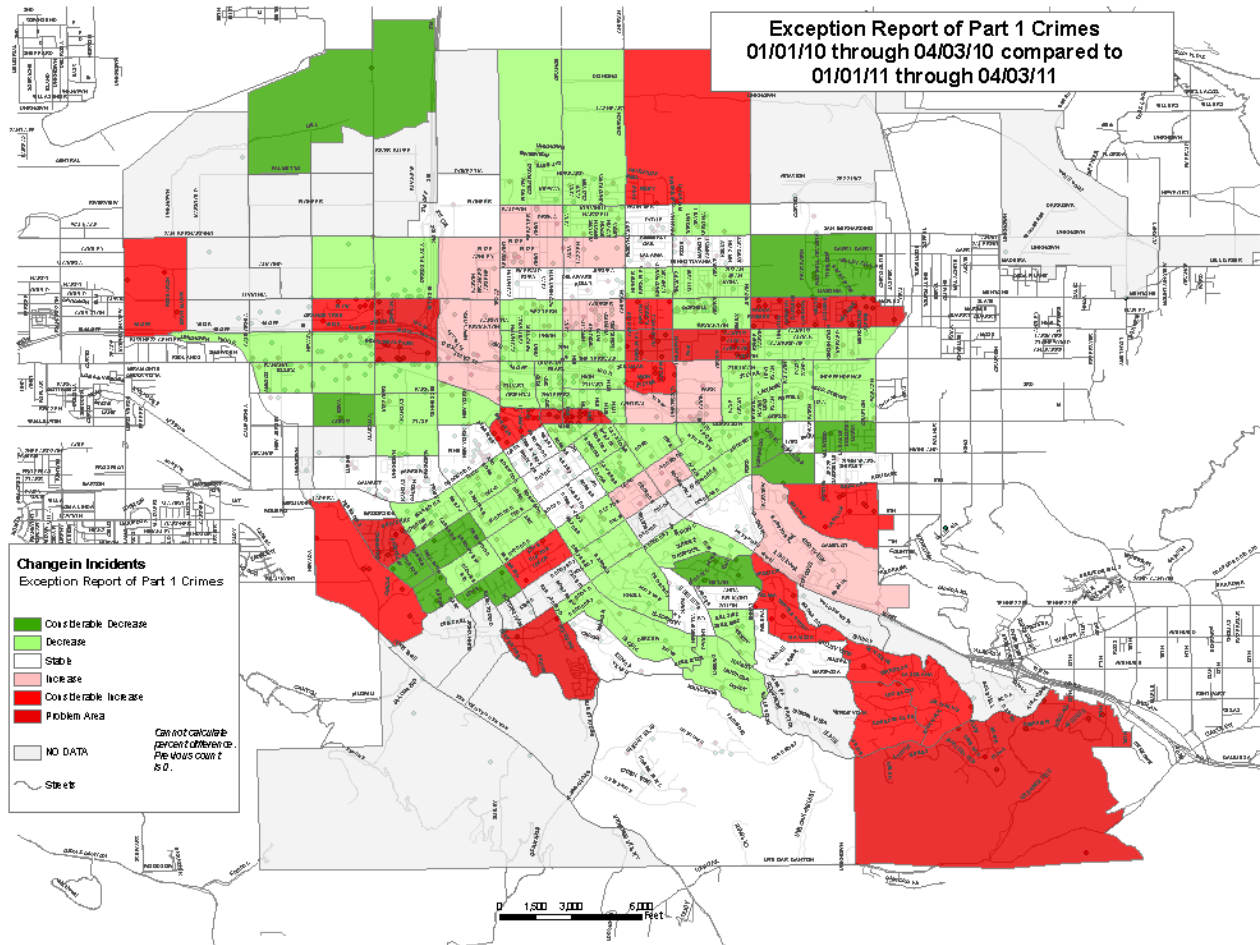
