ADOPT-A-STREET
PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

Redlands Adopt-A-Street and _____
(name of business, organization or individual, hereinafter the "Entity") recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free and visually-improved streets.

The **Adopt-A-Street** program has been established for community and civic organizations as well as private businesses and industry to contribute toward the effort of maintaining cleaner and more beautiful streets in Redlands. The purpose of Redlands' **Adopt-A-Street** program is to encourage community residents and organizations to adopt local blocks of streets and keep them litter-free. The adopted areas are to be cleaned **every 3 months** in an effort to maintain a healthy environment and to produce feelings of pride in our beautiful city.

The Entity understands that the work to be performed can result in physical injury or damage to property and agrees to assume the risk. The Entity hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the City of Redlands, and any neighborhood committee, their officers, employees and agents respectively from liability for any and all claims, damages or injuries of any kind or nature which the Entity, its employees, members or agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program.

The Entity agrees that signs bearing the group's name will be installed solely at the discretion of Redlands Adopt-A-Street.

Redlands Adopt-A-Street recognizes the Entity:

as the adopting organization for Street Name and Description (from what point to what point):

The Entity volunteers are to pick up litter at least **every 3 months** (or more if necessary) along its section of street for a period beginning _____, 20____, and ending _____, 20____.

Contract commitment is for at least 2 years.

Items provided for clean-up are: Clean-up reports (to be turned in after each clean-up), work gloves, trash bags and safety vests. **If safety vests are misplaced, the group will be responsible for their replacement.**

***Items collected by Redlands Adopt-A-Street participants should be litter and debris that can fit into trash bags provided. Volunteer participants are encouraged to separate recyclable items from other debris. Tires, brush and other bulky items should be stacked nearby **not** on top of or under trash bags. Bags of collected trash should not exceed 20- 25 pounds. **Filled bags should be clustered in convenient locations for solid waste collection.** Bags should not be placed in the road or sidewalk. The Entity contact person should call the Quality of Life Department the following working day to report where bags of trash have been left.
