

MINUTES of the Recreation Commission meeting of the City of Redlands held on May 10, 2006 at 4:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, Civic Center Plaza, 35 Cajon Street, Redlands, CA 92373.

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Cencirulo.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

On motion of Chair Cencirulo, seconded by Commissioner Gonzales the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes of all present, the minutes from the April 12<sup>th</sup> meeting.

3. **REGONITIONS**

Mr. Sattler recognized Beatrice Sanchez for her service with the Redlands Recreation Youth Coalition Teen Committee. Ms. Sanchez just recently started to volunteer with the program and has already volunteered over 60 hours.

4. **COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT**

Mr. Sattler informed the commission that Council Member Aguilar will be the new liaison for the Recreation Commission; unfortunately he was unable to attend.

5. **SCHOOL DISTRICT REPORT** – None

6. **OLD BUSINESS**

A. Discussion on parks and recreation commission meetings– Mr. Sattler opened the discussion reminding the commissioners that traditionally the commission goes dark in July and August. He also discussed future joint meetings with the Parks Commission and determined that it would be a good idea to meet in September to review the Redlands Baseball for Youth facility use agreement. Commissioner Peoples asked to reexamine the priority list for both Parks and Recreation Commissions. Commissioner Savage will act as a liaison between the Parks and Recreation Commission and report back to the Recreation Commission On June 14<sup>th</sup>. On motion of Chair Cencirulo, seconded by Commissioner Gonzales the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes of all present, to meet jointly with the Parks Commission in September.

7. **NEW BUSINESS**

A. Community Center Mural – Aaron Hecker discussed his plans to build a frame for a mural to be placed at the Community Center. He requested the sum of \$790.20 to purchase materials to build panels, and a border for the mural project. On motion of Commissioner Peoples,

seconded by Commissioner Thompson the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes of all present, the budget for the project.

- B. Kinder Dance, Ballet & Tap, and Portrait Painting Proposal- Recreation Coordinator Erin Sanborn spoke on behalf of Tiffany Collins in regards to several new classes planned at the Community Center. On motion of Chair Cencirulo, seconded by Commissioner Peoples the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes of all present, the new classes with a recommendation that the City Council approves each independent contract.
- C. Recreation Program Fees- Mr. Sattler informed the commission that per their request the Youth Basketball program will not be cut from the budget. The Commissioners then reviewed resolution 5894 and made the following decisions: On motion of Chair Cencirulo, seconded by Commissioner Peoples the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes of all present, to increase field and facility rental rates for groups 2 and 3 by \$5.00, increase the entire facility rental to \$750.00 from \$700.00, increase youth sport programs by \$3.00 to \$5.00, and increase the percentage collected by the city for independent contract instructors to 30/70 %.
- D. North Redlands Vision Plan Draft- Commissioner Gonzales presented a copy of the North Redlands Vision Plan to the commissioners and discussed the visionary committee's ideas of future recreation facilities and programs specifically within the North Redlands area. Commissioner Peoples agreed with the plan and reiterated the need to reexamine the priority list for the Recreation Commission. On motion of Chair Cencirulo, seconded by Commissioner Peoples the Recreation Advisory Commission approved, by AYE votes to vote on the list at the next meeting.
- E. Open Space Committee Report- Commissioner Savage updated the commissioners on the progress made by the open space committee and the future development of the Santa Anna River Wash project.

Recreation Report – Mr. Sattler updated the commissioners on several summer programs including the Summer Music program which brings the artists who perform at the Redlands Bowl Friday nights to the children at the Community Center for a shortened performance on Saturday mornings beginning July 8 through August 26th. The bureau also participated in the 3rd Annual Airport Fly-In as well as a free youth soccer clinic held at the University of Redlands.
