PROJECT NAME: **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM, 2010 SEWER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT.**

PROJECT ADDRESS: Various locations throughout the City of Redlands.

PROJECT PUBLIC BENEFIT: Many sewer pipelines throughout the City of Redlands were constructed over 50-60 years ago and are in need of repair. This project removes these old sewer pipelines and replaces them with new sewer pipelines and manhole structures. The end result of the work provides a more efficient and less maintenance intensive sewer pipeline that benefits the citizens of the City of Redlands.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project includes the excavation, removal and replacement of old deteriorated sewer pipelines and sewer manholes structures. Once new sewer pipeline are placed at the designed grade, the excavations are backfilled, and compacted. Finally streets and alleys are returned to the original or better condition.
