PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND PUBLIC BENEFIT:

The purpose of the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Water Pipeline Replacement Project is to replace deteriorated water pipelines or substandard size pipelines that are not economical for repair and to improve reliability for existing customers. The Project will include construction of new and replacement of existing water pipelines throughout the City's service area. These pipelines have been programmed for construction in the CIP project list, as updated with input from field staff on problem areas and with input from engineering staff. The Water Pipeline Replacement Project is included in the CIP approved by the Utilities Advisory Committee (UAC) in 2006.

As part of the project, approximately 29,000 linear feet of water pipeline will be replaced.
