



**NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS IN THE
VICINITY OF
(San Timoteo Canyon Road)**

The County of San Bernardino Department of Public Works has contracted with Spiess Construction Co., Inc. for the Maintenance of the San Timoteo Creek Basins in the Redlands area. The construction shall include hauling material from just south of Fern Ave, at the frontage Road, (near the railroad crossing) southward on San Timoteo Canyon Road to Redlands Boulevard in Riverside County and then along Redlands Boulevard to the 60 Freeway. We are anticipating as many as 300 truck loads per day will be added to the traffic along San Timoteo Canyon Road.

This work will be performed starting on or about October 26 of this year through February of next year.

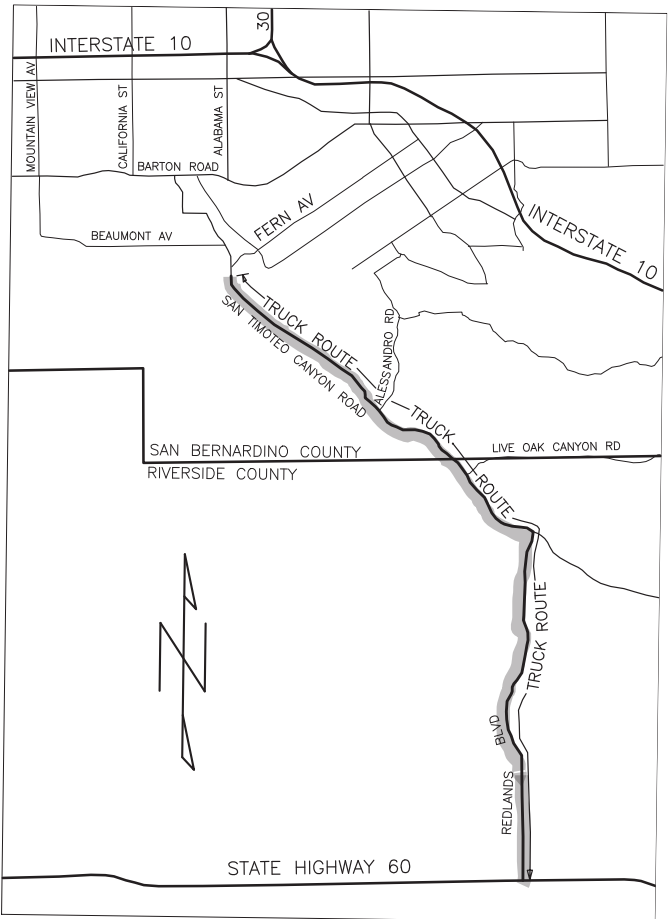

TRUCKS ENTER AND EXIT SAN TIMOTEO ROAD JUST SOUTH OF FERN AVENUE, NEAR RAILROAD CROSSING. TRUCKS TRAVEL SOUTH ON SAN TIMOTEO CANYON ROAD TO REDLANDS BOULEVARD. THEY TURN RIGHT ONTO REDLANDS BOULEVARD AND GO TO STATE HIGHWAY 60. THE EMPTY TRUCKS COME BACK ALONG THE SAME ROUTE.
