PROJECT PUBLIC BENEFIT: ..... Many sewer pipelines throughout the City of Redlands were constructed over 50-60 years ago and are in need of repair. This project removes these old sewer pipelines and replaces them with newer sewer pipelines and manhole structures. The end result of this work provides a more efficient and less maintenance intensive sewer pipe line that benefits the citizens of the City of Redlands.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:..... This project involves the excavation, removal and replacement of old deteriorated sewer pipelines and sewer manhole structures. Once new sewer pipelines are placed at the designed grade, the excavations are backfilled, and compacted. Finally new asphalt concrete is placed with new traffic striping as needed.
